What are the aims and objectives of your organisation?
To hold a local eisteddfod every year to promote Welsh language and culture within Cardiff. We hold homework and stage competitions. We were set up in 2020, and held our first eisteddfod yn January 2020. Unfortunately, we had to help virtual eisteddfods in the following 2 years, but came back in person 2023.

With rising costs, funding is essential to ensure we can still hold the eisteddfod. We c

What do you require the grant for?

General administrative costs, including renting Ysgol Glantaf for the event.

How have you identified a need for the project?

Following 2018 national eisteddfod in Cardiff, we identified that there was no local eisteddfod in Cardiff, despite there being an eisteddfod in most other areas in Wales. More than one group of people had come to this conclusion, and the various committees came together to set up the eisteddfod and hold the first one in January 2020. Subsequently we held a virtual eisteddfod in 2021 and 2022, and came back with an in-person eisteddfod in 2023.

How will the project improve the quality of life for people who live in, work or visit R&M?

The eisteddfod is intended to provide opportunity for all residents of Cardiff and the surrounding areas to take part in competitions. This is a chance for groups to form in the community to compete, as well as compete as individuals. This includes R&M residents, including school aged children.

What are the consequences of not undertaking this project?

The eisteddfod will go ahead for 2024, however securing regular funding is the only way to ensure the eisteddfod is run in years to come. There is an obvious appetite for a local eisteddfod in Cardiff, as demonstrated by the numbers of competitors for the past 4 years. In 2020 we had over 500 people through the door. The numbers were lower in 2023, however we estimate this was down to lowered appetite, given that COVID was still lurking around.

When will the project/activity start and finish?

The eisteddfod is held on 26 January, starting around 4pm and ending by midnight (hopefully!)

The eisteddfod is open to all across Wales (and beyond). However for stage competitions, we tend to target children and young people living in Cardiff, as well as community groups of adults who live across Cardiff.

We know that some members of various society live in the area, through anecdotal evidence. We will also be targeting all schools in Cardiff to let them know that they can compete in homework and stage competitions.
