	Bryn Deri & Radyr Schools Orchestra and Choir
What do you require the grant for?	The PTA would like to apply for funds to cover some of the cost of the Bryn Deri Orchestra and Choir.
How have you identified a need for the project?	The Summer and Winter Term 2023 and Spring Term 2024, cost to Bryn Deri for the individuals from Glamorgan Music School who lead the Bryn Deri & Radyr Primary Schools Cluster Orchestra and Choir is £40 per hour. (see appendix 2: SLA with Glamorgan Music School)
How will the project improve the quality for life for people who live in, work or visit R&M	Orchestra and Choir will each rehearse an hour a week for 36 weeks during the period April 2023 to March 2024.
What are the consequences of not undertaking the project?	This is a total cost of £2,880.
When will the project / activity start and finish?	The PTA would like to contribute 25% of this cost, and are asking for 75% of the total cost as a grant. Due to other financial commitments, the PTA would not be able to contribute the full cost of this project.
Who will benefit from the grant	<p>Thanks to the previous grant from R&MCC, the choir and orchestra were able to perform at Lighting of the Christmas Tree Christmas Concerts in Dec 2022 and the May Festival 2023 as well as other occasions at Bryn Deri School. The number of children taking part in the orchestra and choir is growing and we see this trend continuing.</p> <p>Pupils feel like valued members of the community by taking part in community events, e.g.. Members of the community enjoy listening to the children performing.</p> <p>The whole community will benefit and it will also support the designated charity of the Radyr and Morganstown Festival by attracting families to the planned events.</p>

Bryn Deri Year 5 Garden	
What do you require the grant for?	The PTA would like to apply for funds to cover some equipment to enhance the year 5 garden.
How have you identified a need for the project?	Until recently, year 5 did not have any outside space of their own. During the summer term, the Teacher and Teaching assistant began to create a usable garden out of what was previously an unused stretch of grass near their classroom.
How will the project improve the quality for life for people who live in, work or visit R&M	Children have enjoyed growing tomatoes and sunflowers. One of the Dads donated a wooden bench and another parent donated a bird feeder.
What are the consequences of not undertaking the project?	We would like to enhance this area to give year 5 more opportunity to spend time outside, learning about the environment, working in groups, and creating a special place to enjoy.
When will the project / activity start and finish?	£250 would enable the PTA to purchase tools and items to make raised beds, and bug hotels.
Who will benefit from the grant	This project will benefit children in year 5 for many years to come.
