- the need to remove information from the Council's old website, including references to Hallmaster.
- the importance of keeping the Home Page up to date.
- the need to add details of the days when the Council's offices are staffed are shown on the Contact Us page and a note is included about access to Hallmaster.
- the potential to update reference to the Council's Twitter account.

It was **Recommended** that:

- (2) the issues highlighted above are taken forward as part of the ongoing development of the site.
