### **1. Apologies for Absence**

Apologies for Absence were accepted from Councillor Michelle Lenton-Johnson (Illness).

### **2. Declarations of Interest**

Members were asked to declare any personal and/or prejudicial interest they had and give details of their interest. None were made.

### **3. Members of the Public Invited to Speak**

No members of the public were present.

### **4. Minutes of the previous meeting 2 November 2023**

The Minutes of the meeting held on 2 November 2023 were confirmed as a correct record. The Minutes were signed by the Chair of Publicity & Communications Committee.

### **5. Remembrance 2023**

- (i) The Act of Remembrance was well received by all who attended.
- (ii) The Church Service was well attended.
- (iii) The Reception in the Tennis Club was well received but with very few people attending. Suggestions were made that the Vicar could remind people about the Reception during the Service.

Cllr Shariff asked if everything was documented for the Remembrance Service, and it was confirmed that Ian Ogden had this in hand. A

suggestion was made to meet 2-3 times to go through things before for next year.

## 6. **Christmas Events 2023**

### **To review the success of Events organised or supported by the Council**

- (i) Tree Lighting is a joint event with the RMA and the Council and was well attended. There was a lack of Members to front an RMCC stall and suggestions made were for Member to put this in the diary early.
- (ii) Santa Sleigh Run was well received throughout Radyr & Morganstown.
- (iii) The Christmas Meal was well attended by Councillors and Guests. A few suggestions have been made for next year by some Members.

## 7. **Work Programme:**

The Assistant Clerk has had some training from Webjects regarding the publishing of Agenda's, Minutes and Notes.

Members discussed setting up a Facebook Page when a new Clerk is appointed.

The Old R&MCC Website still appears to be available to view by members of the public. Members had asked a number of times for this to be closed down or unpublished as soon as possible, but it had not happened. Survey work was discussed, and the Council's Website includes this facility.

Members also discussed the use of SmartSurvey for a short period of time.
