The committee recommended that, as landlord of the building, R&MCC would investigate the legal position of making a grant and would also await the result of the application to the Aggregate Levy Fund. 13.360 TO RECEIVE THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The financial statement for October was presented to the committee. 13.360.1 The balance in the cash book at September 30 was £90,783.41 13.360.2 £1,170 remains in the grant budget. 13.361 TO RECEIVE A SIX-MONTH STATEMENT ON THE COUNCIL'S EXPENDITURE: The statement was received. 13.362 TO CONSIDER IDEAS FOR EXPENDITURE IN 2014-15: The Clerk asked for suggestions for next year's budget to be submitted before November's meeting. 13.363 TO CONSIDER LEGAL COSTS FOR THE OCR TRANSFER: The Clerk had received quotes for this of £750 and £500 plus Land Registry fees (£50). It was recommended to accept lower quote. 13.364 TO CONSIDER EXPENDITURE ON THE OCR CELEBRATION: The Clerk had sought three quotes for this at £19.95; £14.95 and £12.00/head. It was recommended to accept the lowest quote. 13.365 TO RECOMMEND EXPENDITURE FOR THE WW1 PROJECT: The committee recommended expenditure up to £300.00 be allocated for this project. If further funds are needed, the group should make another request. 13.366 TO REVIEW AND SIGN CHEQUES: Twelve cheques were examined and signed for presentation at the Council meeting on 17 October 2013 for final
