Items discussed in meeting with Heads of Radyr Comp, Radyr Primary and Brynderi that link with the RMCC

Halloween.

Radyr Comp for Windsor Gardens Need 12 One for each pillar and two spares that can go by the planter

Brynderi for the path across Pentwyn Park Guess 12 would work.

Radyr Primary (children's choice where) along Park Road or entry to Dan y Bryn woods Suppose we give 12 here too.

Esther and Sam, the half term is 26-30 October

So we will need to get the pumkins to the schools Week starting Monday 12th October

And we will need to collect them on Friday 23rd October (I can help)

We need to store them till Saturday 31st October

(Not sure how practical this is going to be. All depends on whether we can put them out and whether they will store well! So we will need to store the decorated pumpkins at the OCR and then put them out morning of Sat 31st)

FYI It's the weekend of my grandchildren's birthday, so I may not be in Radyr that day.

Need a decision on this quickly so bookings can be arranged. It may be that existing bookings might decide the location for us.

The definite plus with holding it in Radyr Comp is the amount of parking available.

We also need to decide on location for pupils singing if we switch to Plan B

The RMCC had been thinking of adding Christmas lights/ tree to Morganstown Village Hall.
If we are going to use Radyr Comp then we should be looking at a tree in the Comp.
(Depending on where it is sited, it could cheer up the traffic on Heol Isaf during December)

Has anyone asked Cardiff Council for the closure of Station Road? David if you copy me in, at helen.lloydjones@cardiff.gov.uk when you send the request to Cardiff Council, I can follow up. Make sure you point out it is a Community Event to raise money for a Charity, City Hospice.
