12. How have you identified the need for this project	Quite simply the festival is the main income for the club. Without this we would not be able to continue providing the service we do for the local community which is all carried out on a voluntary basis by coaches who are themselves parents. We have 66 coaches across the age groups.

15. How will the project improve the quality of life for people who live in, work, or visit Radyr & Morganstown.	Any extra funds we receive will go towards maintaining the club, help improve facilities and help us achieve our future vision. Every playing child in the area has one hour coaching and one game on a Saturday (subject to weather) at very little cost. Radyr and Morganstown is in one of the most deprived areas in Wales for physical environment and the club help improve young peoples health, fitness and mental wellbeing.			
16. What are the consequences of <i>not</i> undertaking this project?	The club will find it more difficult to keep paying for pitch hire and equipment for all our teams across various age groups

They are supported by both parents and grandparents. We would estimate that the club would then based on 2 parents and some grandparents have a beneficial effect in excess of 1000 people including the players themselves.

We also have children from Radyr comprehensive. There are some children from outside these schools that also play. We are also close to agreeing an over 40s vets team who have a squad of around 30
